Why are we here?

South Yorkshire Safety Camera Partnership is made up of Barnsley, Doncaster, Rotherham and Sheffield Councils, the Highways Agency, Her Majesty's Courts Service and South Yorkshire Police.



Our aim is to make South Yorkshire roads safer and reduce the number of people killed or seriously injured on our roads.

It's working

Since 2002 the South Yorkshire Safety Camera Partnership has worked alongside other organisations to help reduce deaths and serious injuries on our roads.

In 2008 the number of people killed and seriously injured on South Yorkshire roads fell to 585 - the lowest figure since records began in 1979.

The cost of a casualty

The average estimated **cost to the public** for injuries on the road is:

- **£1.8 million** for every **death**
- **£215,000** for every **serious injury**
- **£22,000** for a **slight injury***

And don't forget the **human cost of each casualty**; the pain and suffering of those involved in a collision and their families.

80% of pedestrians hit at 30mph will **live** but 80% of pedestrians hit at 40mph will **die**.

Know your limits

These speed limits apply to all roads unless signs show otherwise.

| | Built-up area (Street lighting*) | Single carriageway | Dual carriageway | Motorway |
|---|-------------------------------------|-----------------------|---------------------|---------------------|
|  | 30 mph | 60 mph | 70 mph | 70 mph |
|  | 30 mph | 50 mph | 60 mph | 60 mph |
|  | 30 mph | 50 mph | 60 mph | 70 mph |
|  7.5 tonnes or less (laden) | 30 mph | 50 mph | 60 mph | 70 mph [‡] |
|  over 7.5 tonnes (laden) | 30 mph | 40 mph | 50 mph | 60 mph |

* A 30mph limit applies to all roads with street lighting unless signs show otherwise.

[‡] 60mph if articulated or towing.

The speed cameras in South Yorkshire are clearly visible and are signed in accordance with guidelines set by the Department for Transport.
