## Request:

Dear South Yorkshire Police I am writing to you under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 to request the following information from South Yorkshire Police Please provide statistical data of the number of vehicles activating the variable speed cameras on the M1 for traffic heading Southbound at Junction 34. Those that were caught speeding and the fines associated with the speeds they were doing. No personal information relating to the vehicle registration or occupants details are required, therefore the data is to be anonymous if possible Please provide the information in the form of an excel/spreadsheet format document.

## Response:

Please see attached Spreadsheet for a detailed breakdown of Offences and Outcomes for the camera covering Junction 35 to 34 Southbound of the M1 Motorway. Revenue generation is not the concern of this organisation. The revenue from fines has always been payable through the Courts system to HM Treasury. The Safety Camera Partnership is a partnership between the four local authorities, South Yorkshire Police, Highways Agency and Her Majesty's Courts Service. Local authorities receive additional funding for road safety through the Local Transport Plan process and it is this funding that is used to finance the Partnership's operations. The number of tickets issued has no bearing on how we operate.
